

Concentrated Disadvantage by County



Percentage of households with children that are located in census tracts for which the averaged z-score of the following factors is above the 75th percentile: family households below the poverty line, individuals receiving public assistance, female-headed households, unemployment age 16 and older and population younger than 18. Counties in higher quintiles have greater disadvantage relative to all U.S. counties.
