Geriatric Clinicians

Suicide

21%▲

from 18.0 to 21.8 deaths per 100,000 adults age 65 and older between 2019-2021 and 2022-2024.

SNAP Reach

13%▼

from 61.4 to 53.5 participants per 100 adults age 60 and older in poverty between 2018 and 2023.

Strengths

- Low prevalence of food insecurity
- High number of home health care workers per 1,000 older adults

Challenges

- High early death rate
- High prevalence of low-care nursing home residents
