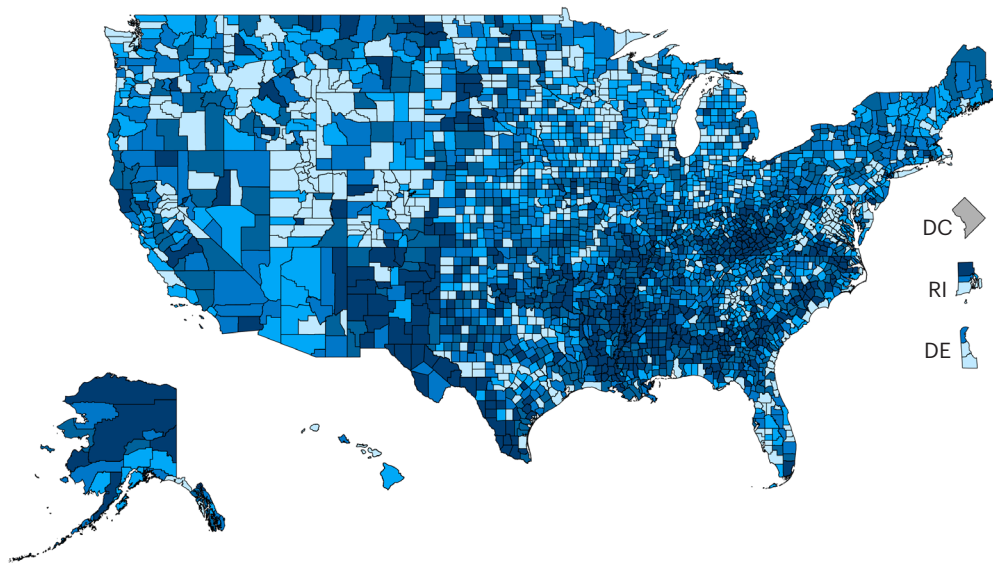

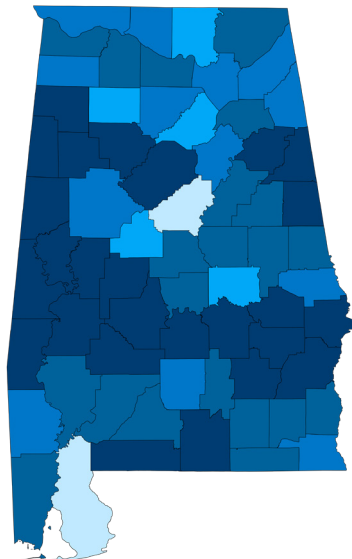

Risk of Social Isolation by County



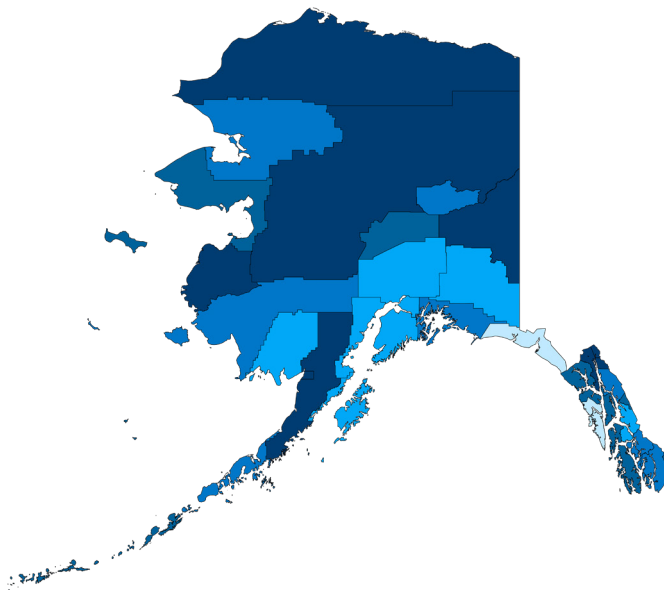

Risk of Social Isolation by County



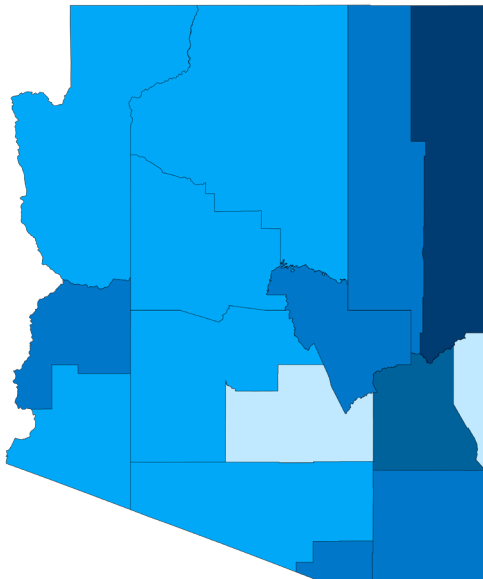

Risk of Social Isolation by County



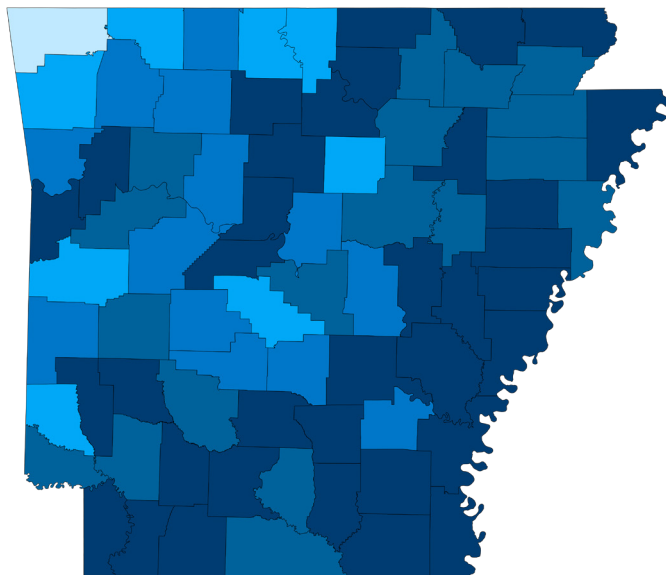

Risk of Social Isolation by County



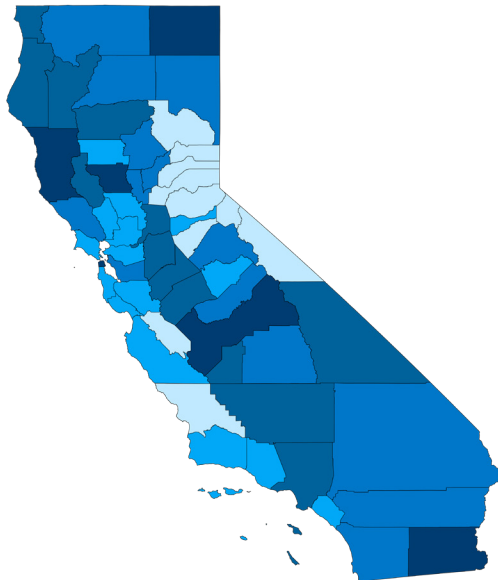

Risk of Social Isolation by County



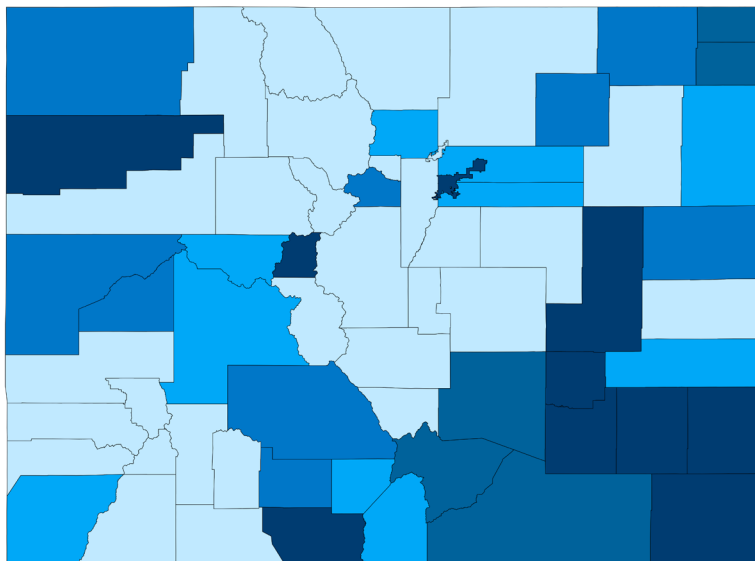

Risk of Social Isolation by County



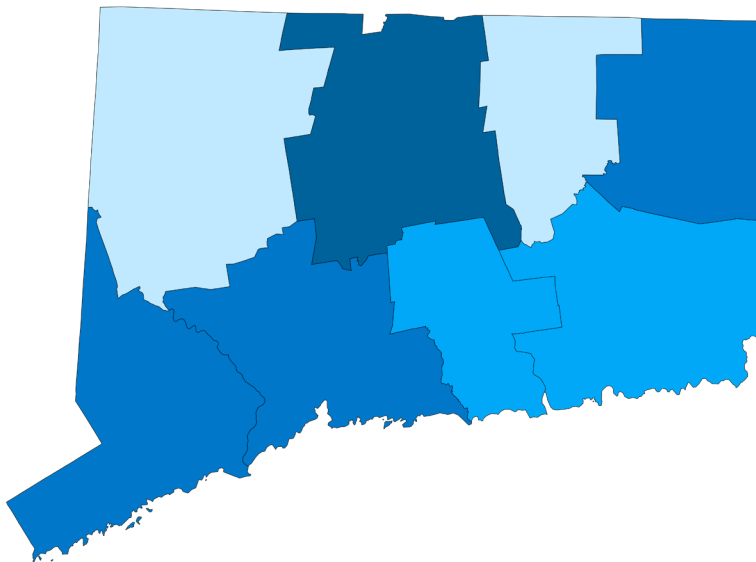

Risk of Social Isolation by County



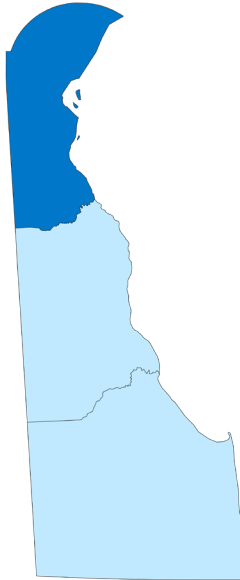

Risk of Social Isolation by County



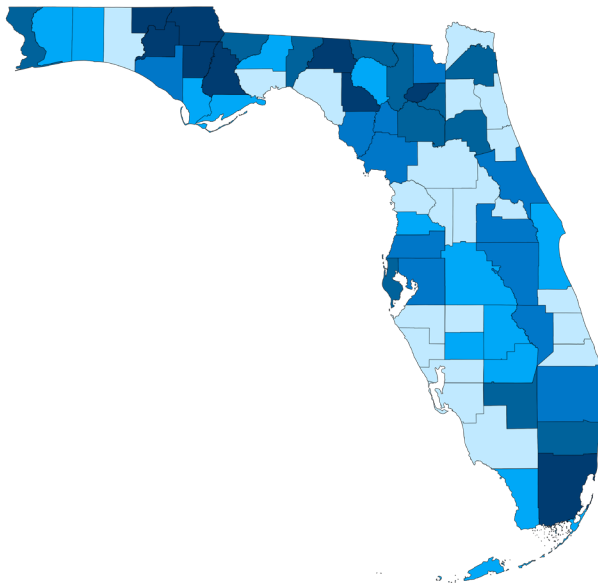

Risk of Social Isolation by County



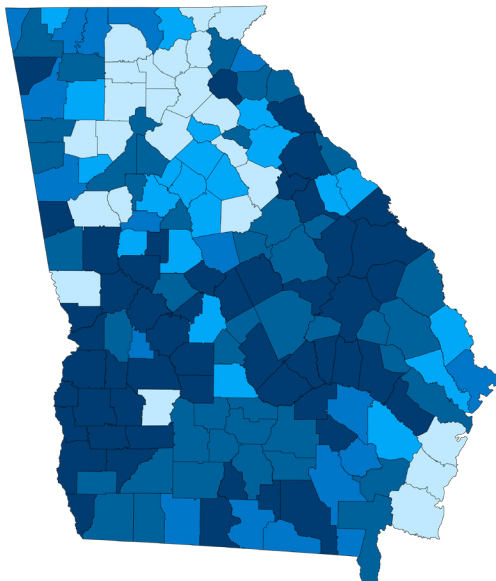

Risk of Social Isolation by County



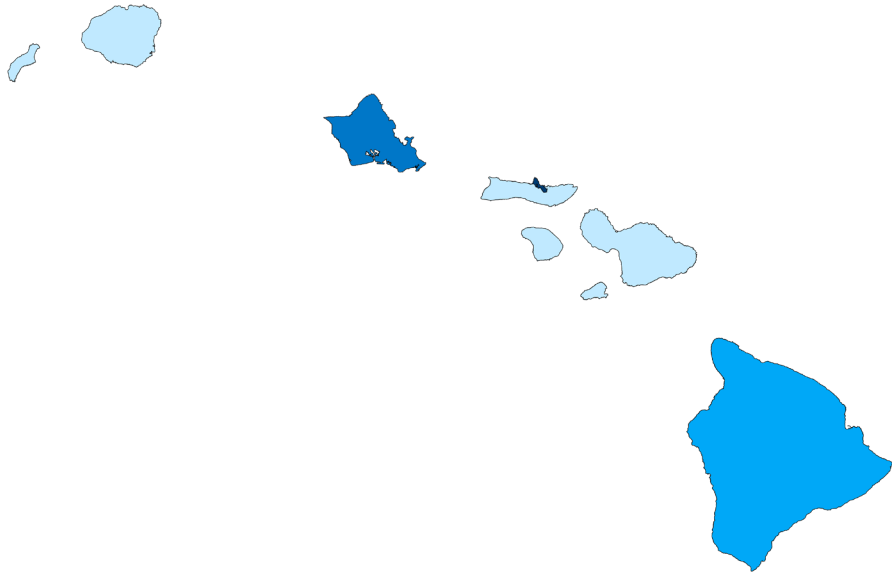

Risk of Social Isolation by County



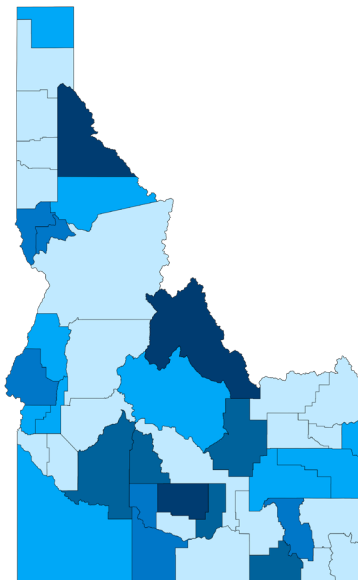

Risk of Social Isolation by County



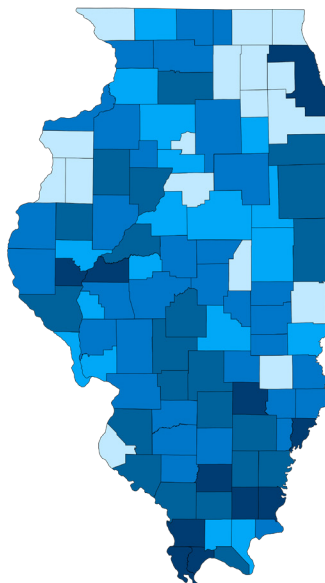

Risk of Social Isolation by County



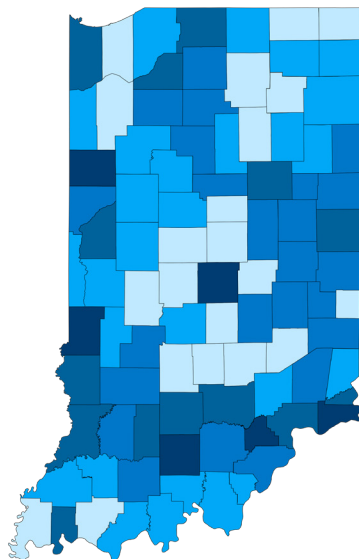

Risk of Social Isolation by County



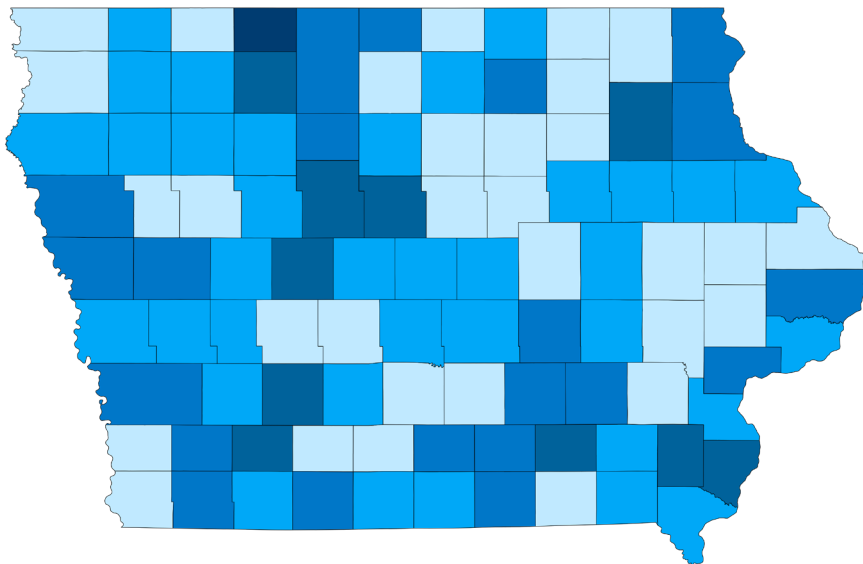

Risk of Social Isolation by County



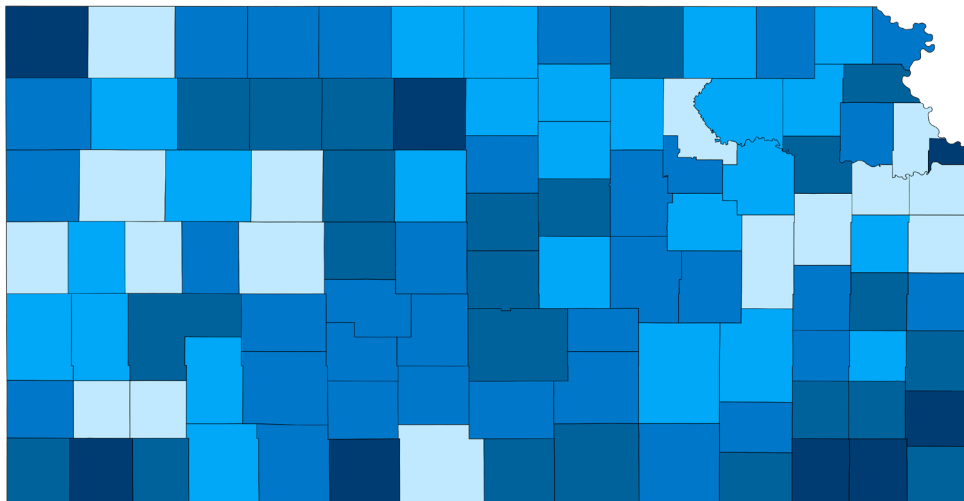

Risk of Social Isolation by County



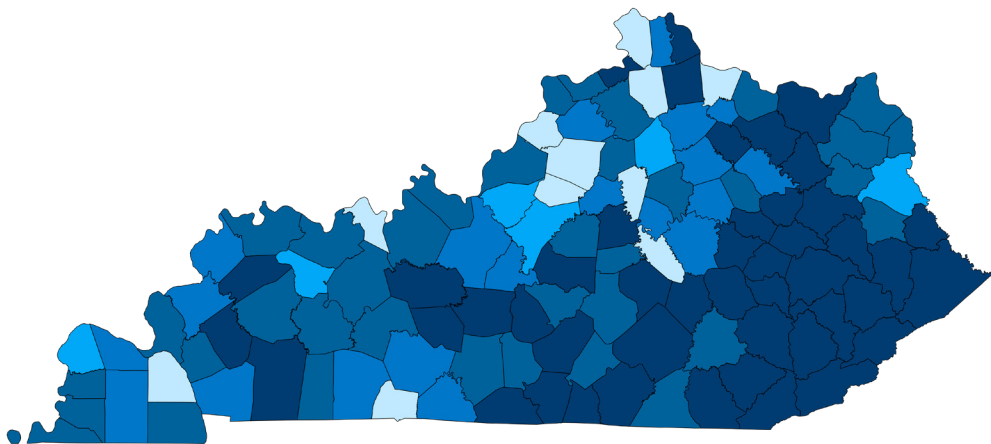

Risk of Social Isolation by County



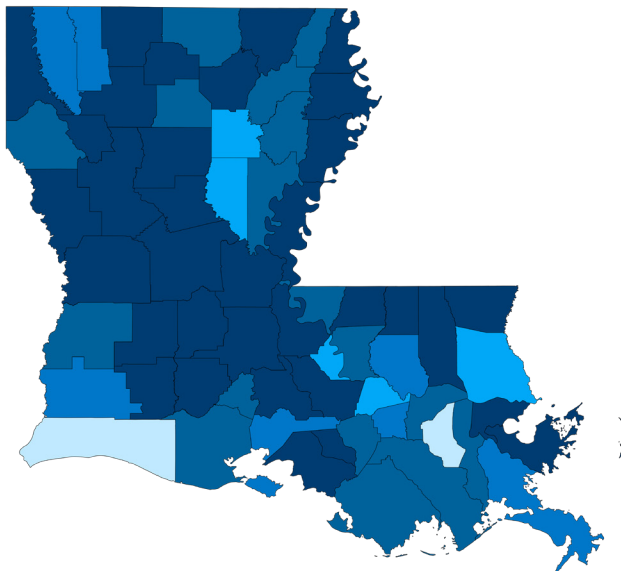

Risk of Social Isolation by County



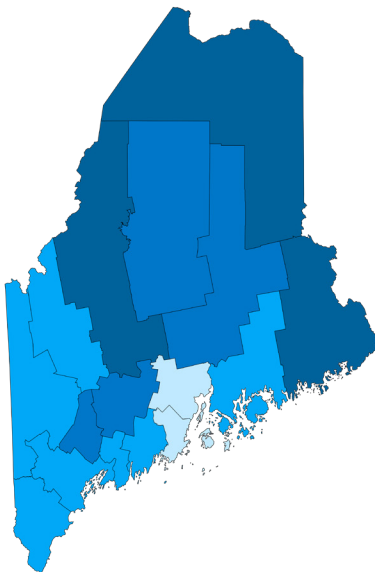

Risk of Social Isolation by County



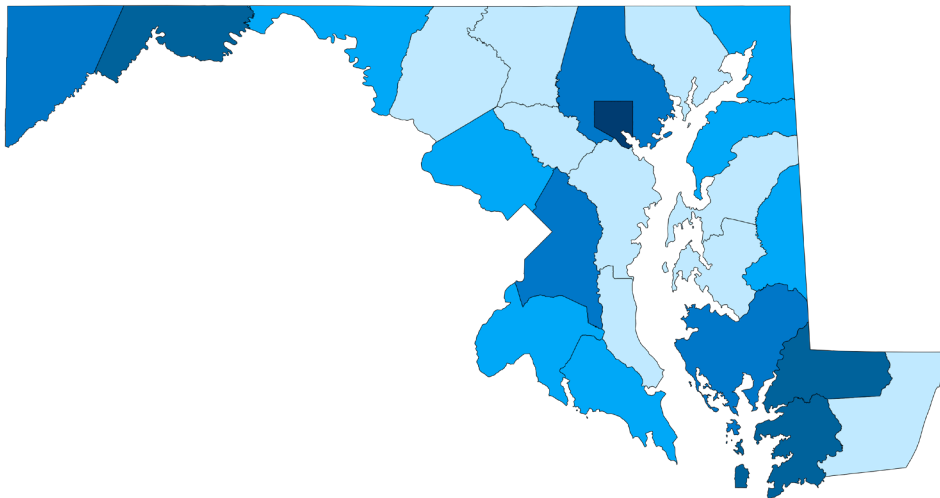

Risk of Social Isolation by County



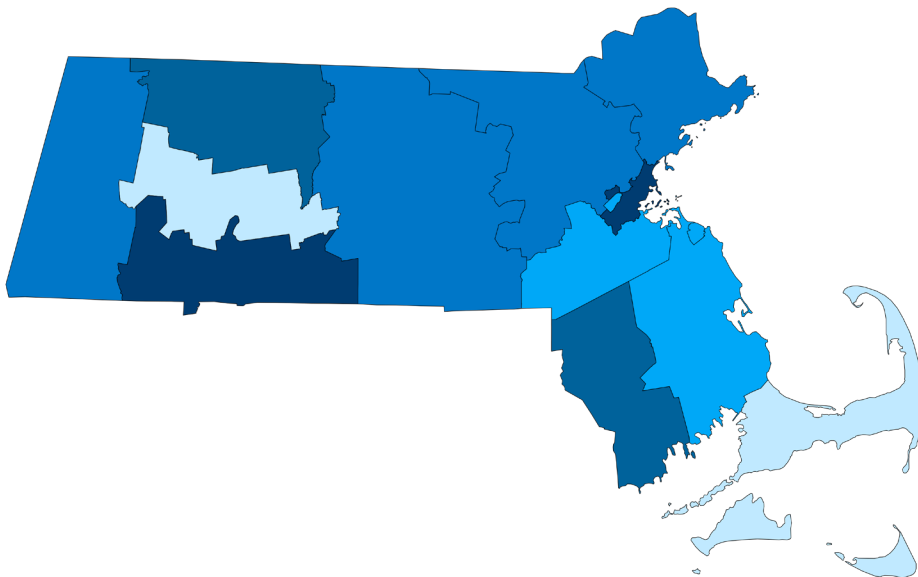

Risk of Social Isolation by County



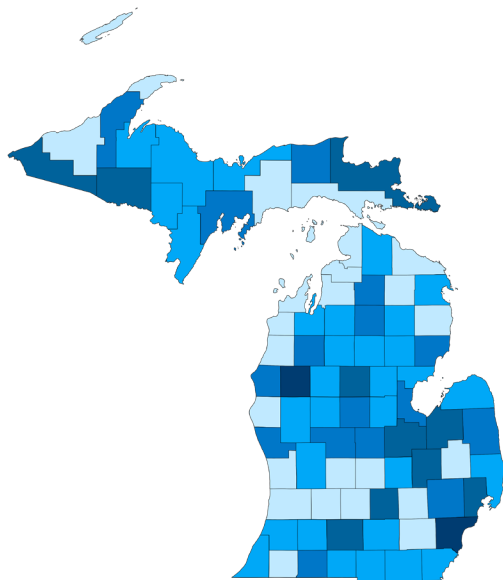

Risk of Social Isolation by County



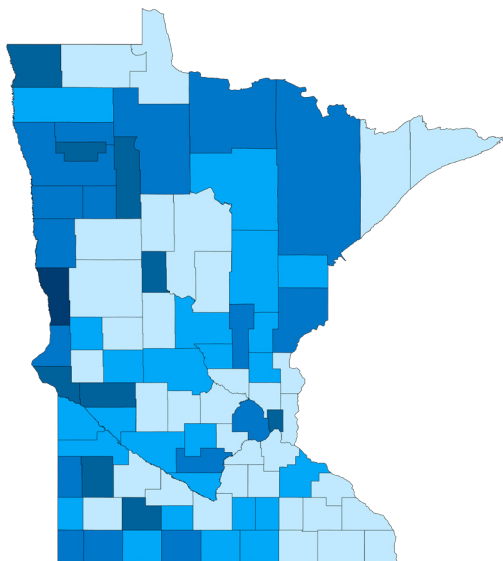

Risk of Social Isolation by County



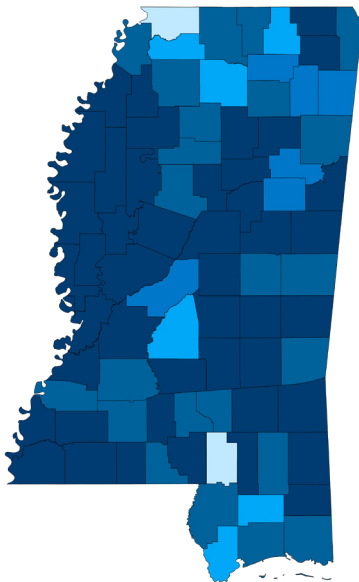

Risk of Social Isolation by County



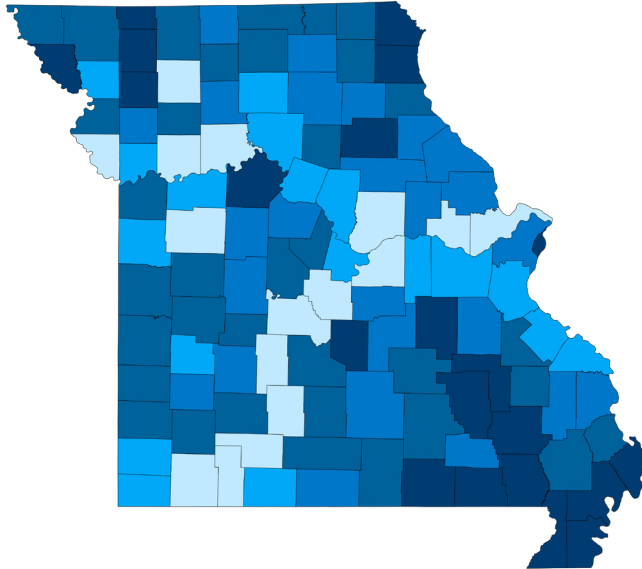

Risk of Social Isolation by County



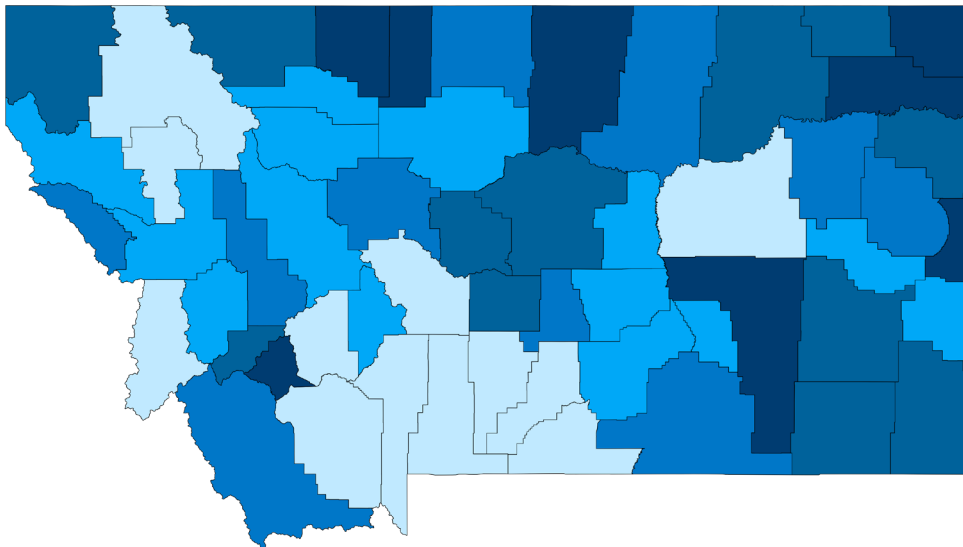

Risk of Social Isolation by County



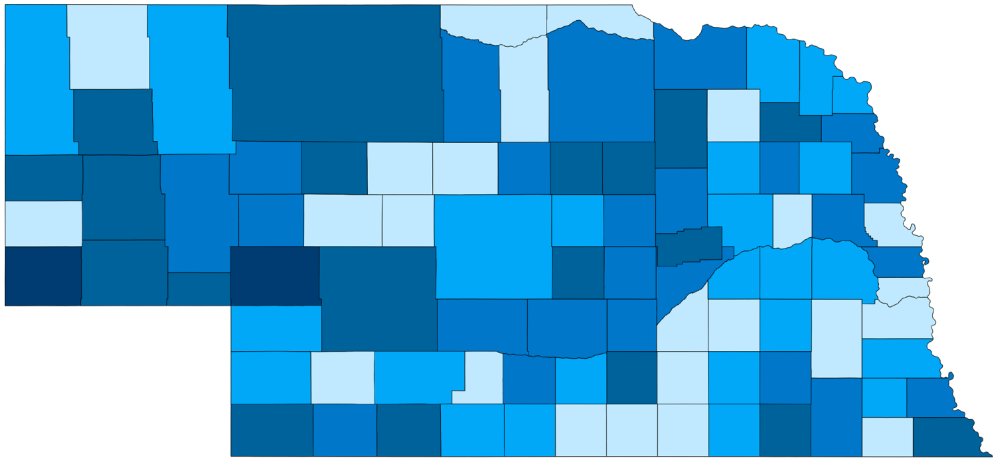

Risk of Social Isolation by County



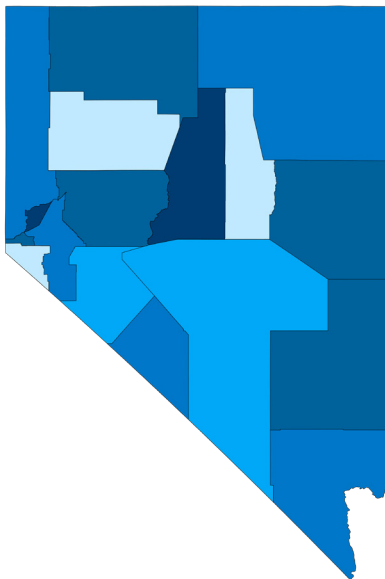

Risk of Social Isolation by County



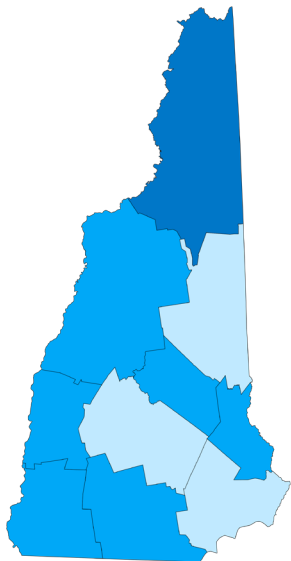

Risk of Social Isolation by County



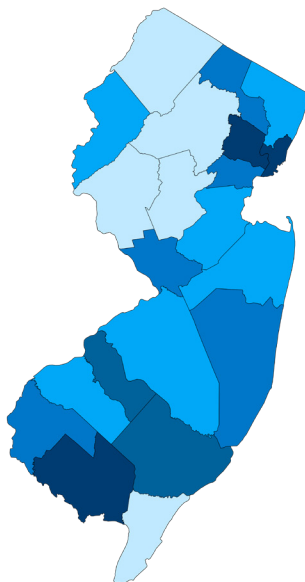

Risk of Social Isolation by County



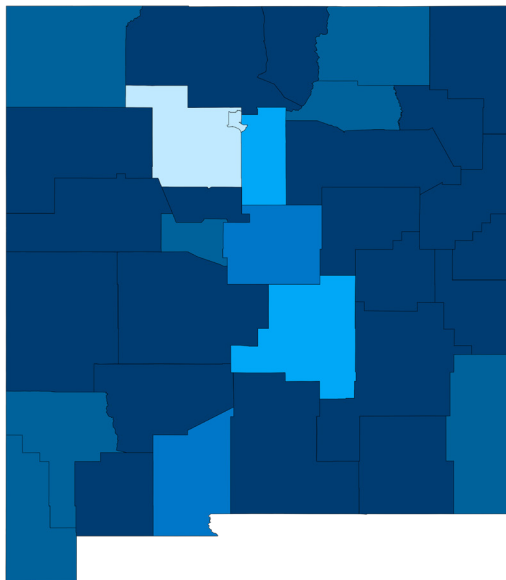

Risk of Social Isolation by County



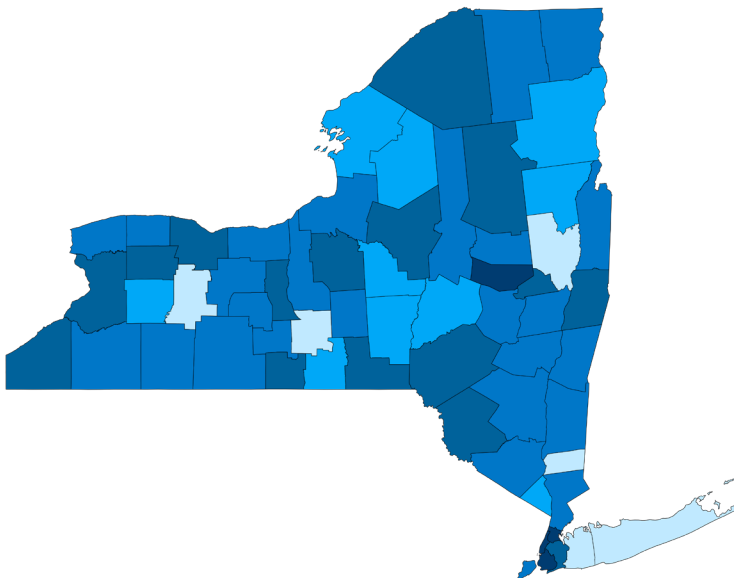

Risk of Social Isolation by County



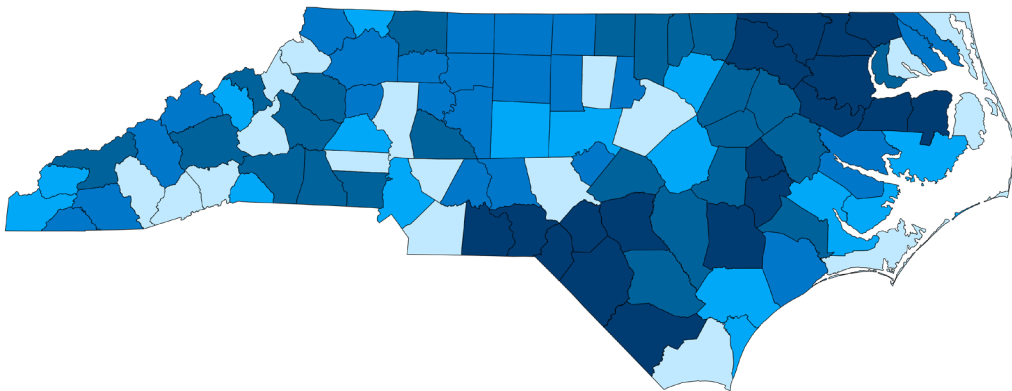

Risk of Social Isolation by County



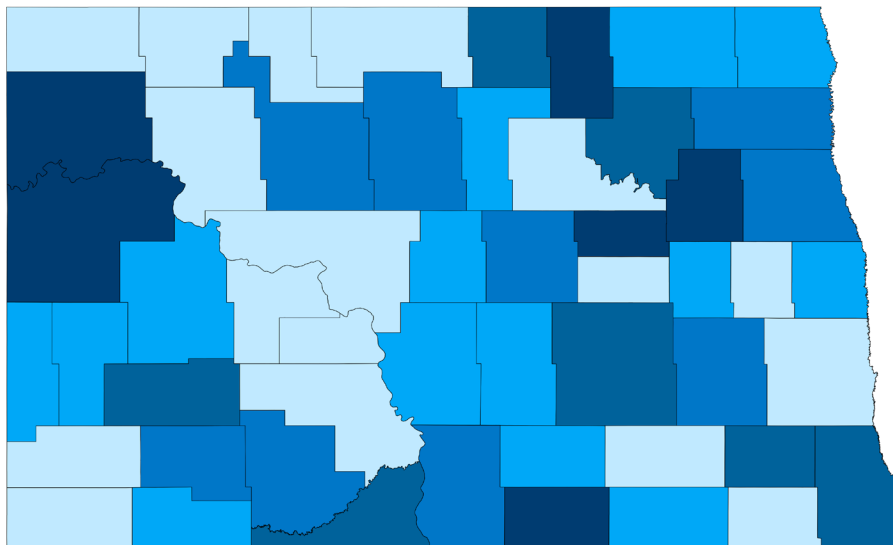

Risk of Social Isolation by County



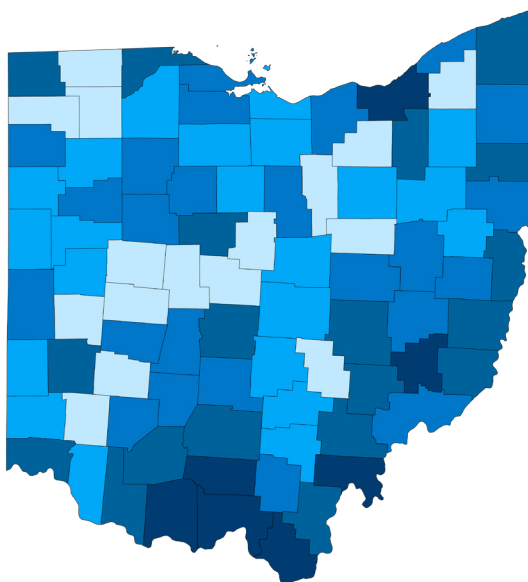

Risk of Social Isolation by County



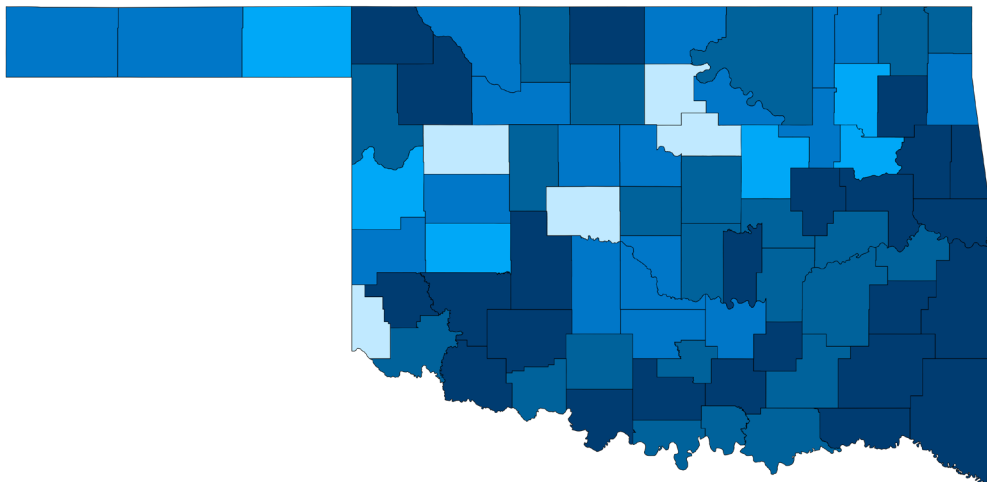

Risk of Social Isolation by County



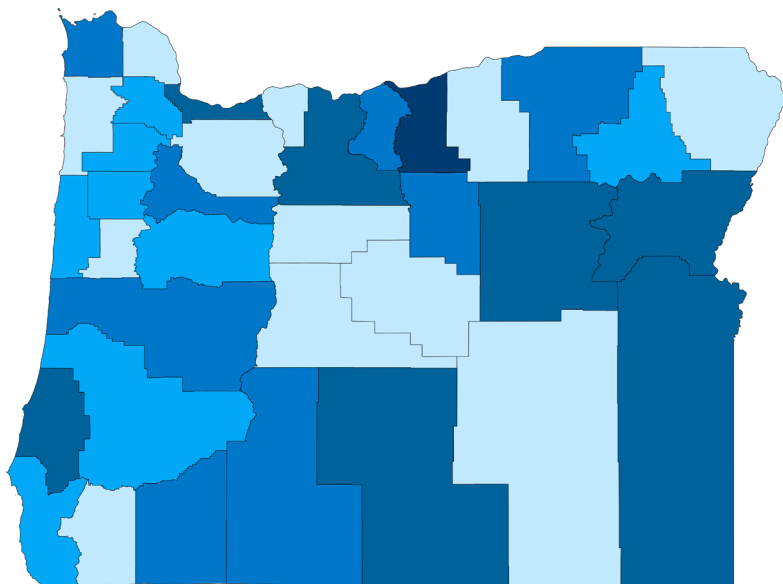

Risk of Social Isolation by County



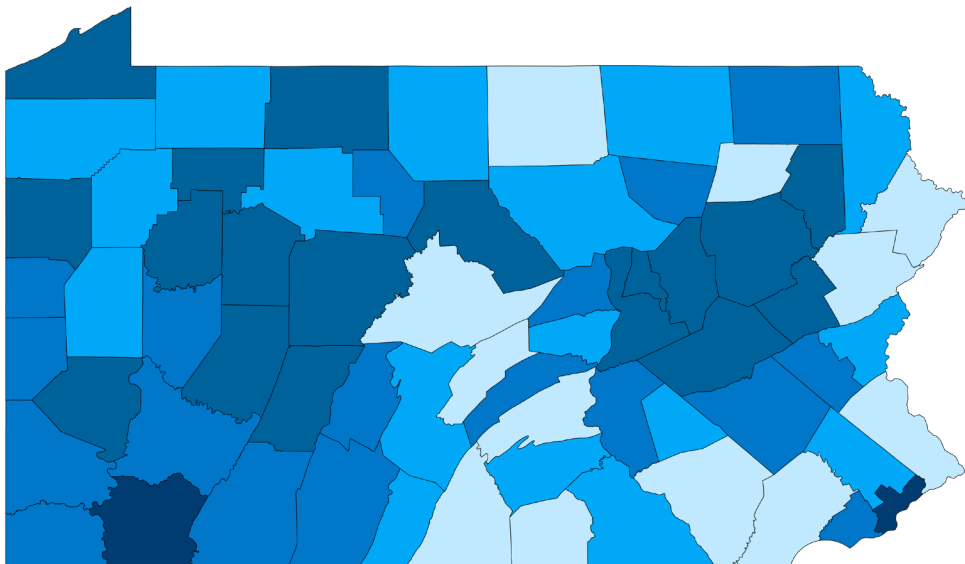

Risk of Social Isolation by County



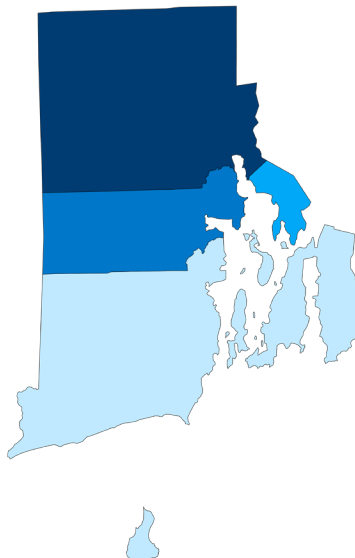

Risk of Social Isolation by County



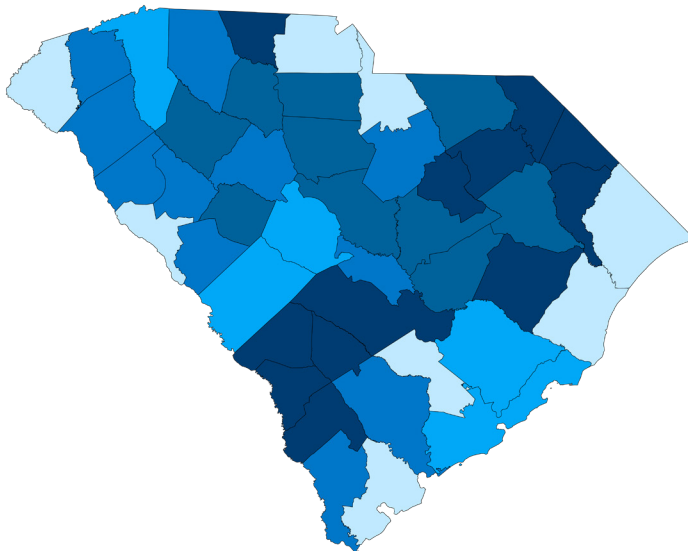

Risk of Social Isolation by County



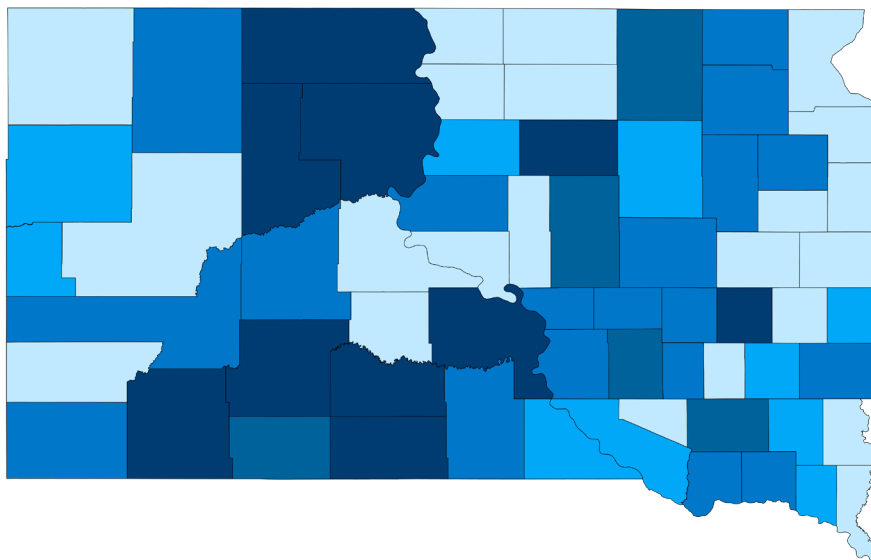

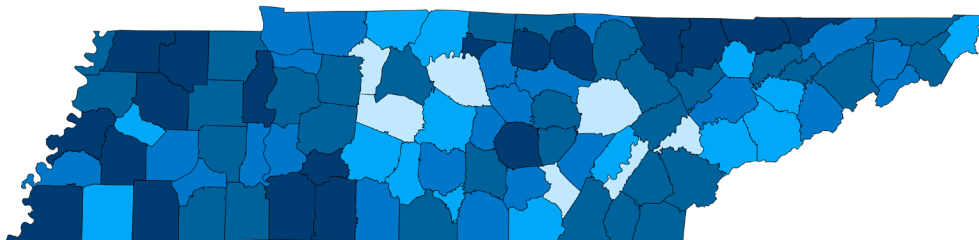

Risk of Social Isolation by County



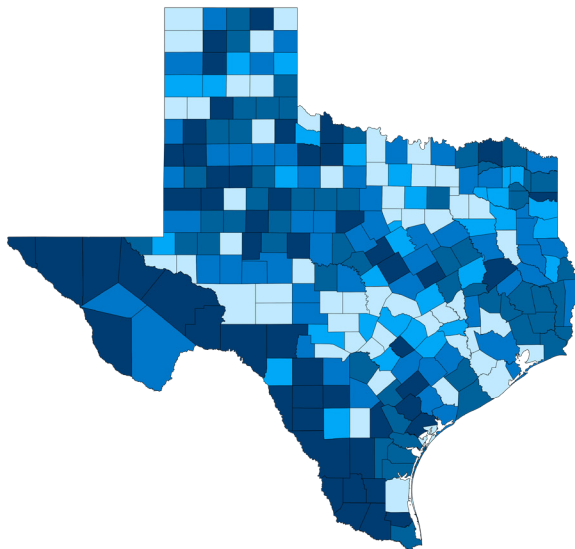

Risk of Social Isolation by County



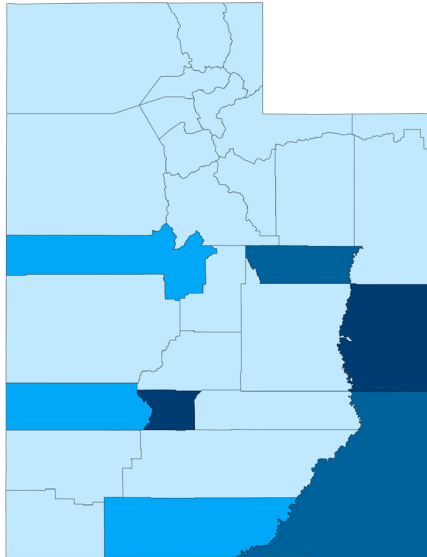

Risk of Social Isolation by County



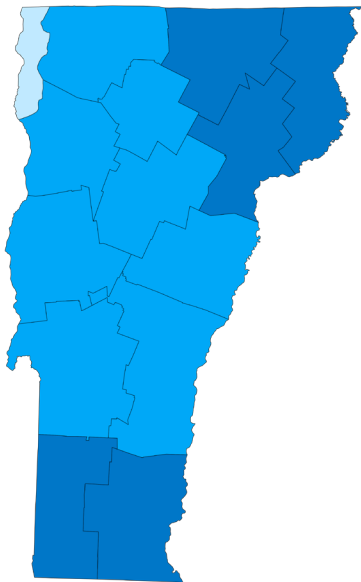

Risk of Social Isolation by County



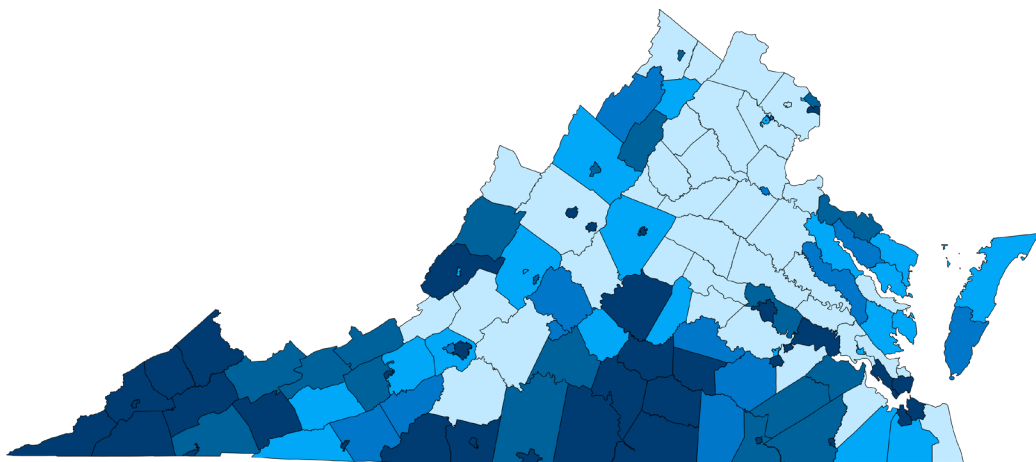

Risk of Social Isolation by County



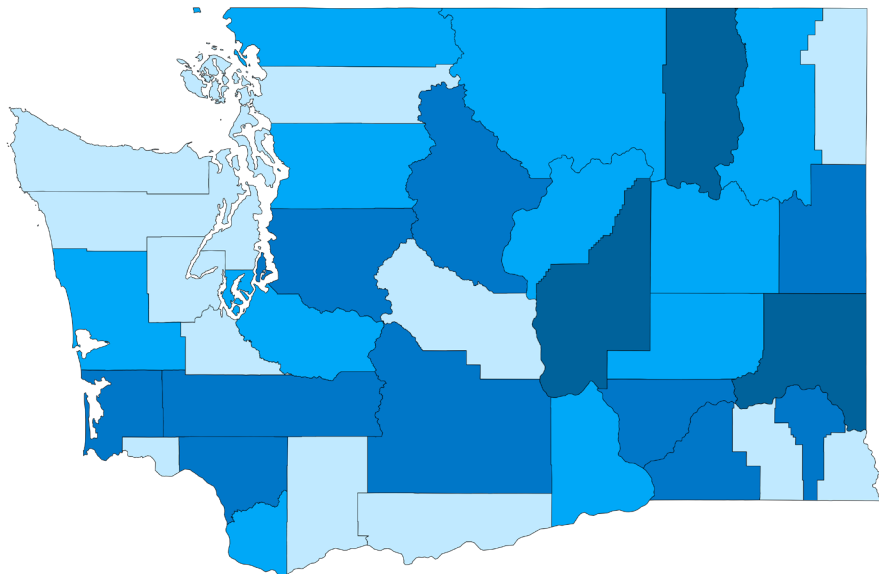

Risk of Social Isolation by County



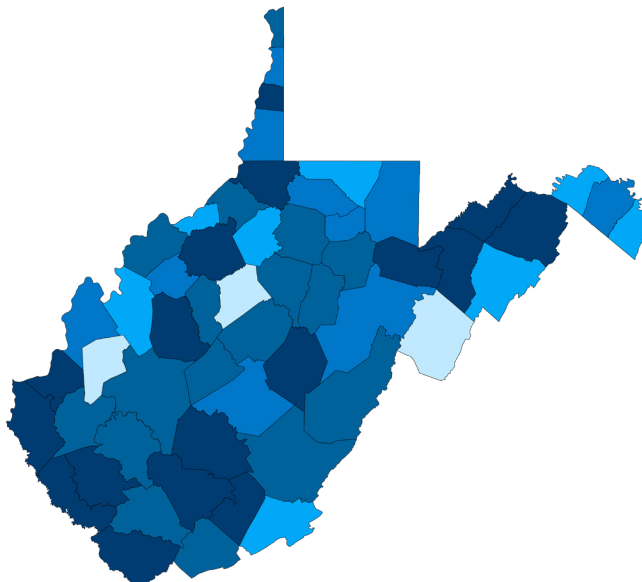

Risk of Social Isolation by County



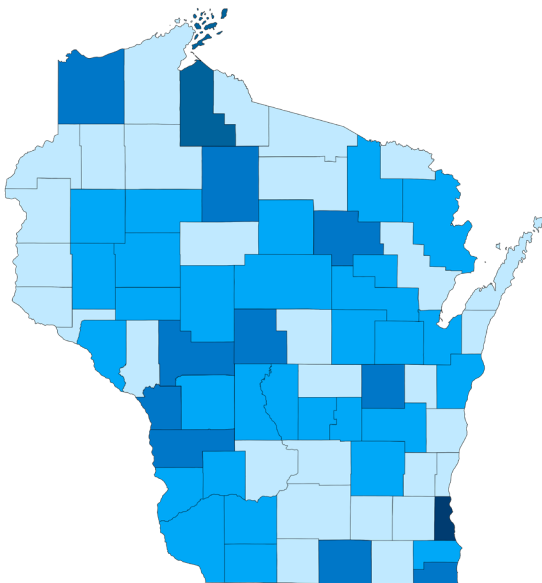

Risk of Social Isolation by County



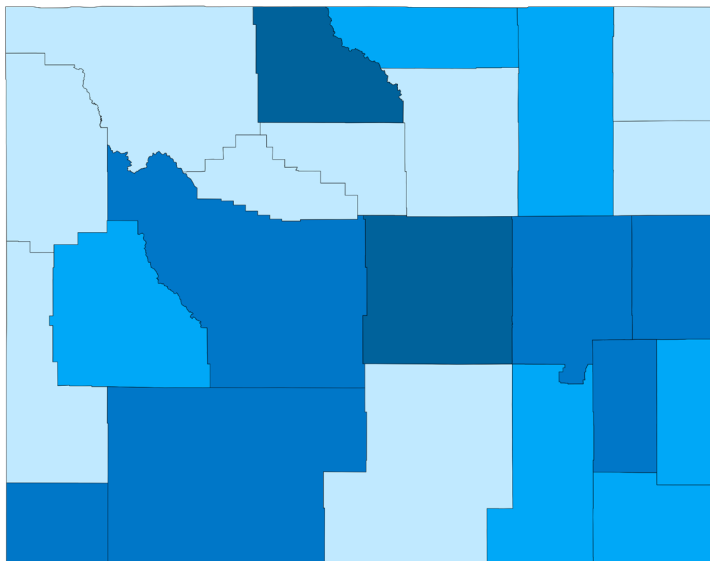
