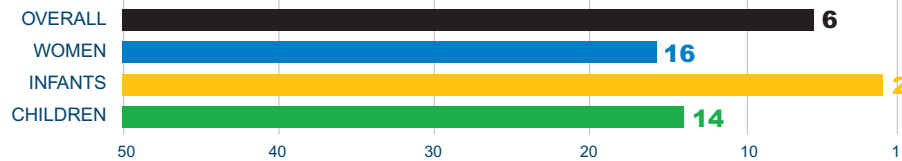

OF **PREGNANT WOMEN AGED 18 TO 44 IN UTAH SMOKE** COMPARED WITH 10.5% NATIONALLY.



### 92.9%

OF BABIES AGED 0 TO 2 YEARS IN UTAH **RECEIVED A WELL-BABY CHECKUP** IN THE PAST 12 MONTHS COMPARED WITH 90.9% NATIONALLY.



### 18.5%

OF CHILDREN AGED 0 TO 17 YEARS IN UTAH HAVE EXPERIENCED **TWO OR MORE ADVERSE EXPERIENCES** COMPARED WITH 22.6% NATIONALLY.



### 7.7%

OF CHILDREN AGED 6 TO 17 YEARS IN UTAH **MISSED 11 OR MORE DAYS IN THE PAST SCHOOL YEAR** COMPARED WITH 6.2% NATIONALLY.
